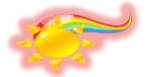


Newsletter Class 11

Always try your best.

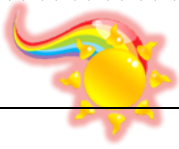
Always try to have a positive attitude.

You can help by:

- Helping your child to write in full complete complex sentences
- Helping your child to recognise numbers up to 1,000,000
- Talking to your child about their day at school and encourage them to talk about new things they have learnt with their learning partners.
- Ensuring uniforms and coats are labelled with your child's name.
- Homework includes reading every day and use of Mathletics /Spellodrome/Reading Eggs
The target is for every child to get 1,000 points on Assertive mentoring in Mathletics and use the wordlists in Spellodrome
